ITEMS ACCEPTED AT COLLECTION CENTERS

- Recyclables: cardboard, newspaper; aluminum & steel (tin) cans;
- Automobile/boat batteries should be placed on the designated pallets.
- Metals, white goods (i.e. stoves, refrigerators, freezers, etc.) yard waste, tires (maximum of 5/resident), household construction debris and furniture should be placed in the designated containers/areas.
- Household solid waste should be bagged and placed in the compactor.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT COLLECTION CENTERS

Roofing Shingles

*Burn Barrels *Dead Animals *Hazardous Waste or Liquids *Used Motor Oil

NOTE: Glass bottles and jars and plastic containers for recycling may be taken to New River Regional Landfill.
