

FIRST AMENDMENT TO  
THE NEW RIVER SOLID WASTE ASSOCIATION  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the NEW RIVER SOLID WASTE ASSOCIATION INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 19 day of May, 1997 by and between Baker County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; Bradford County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and Union County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Counties."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Counties entered into an INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT creating the NEW RIVER SOLID WASTE ASSOCIATION on July 5, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the NEW RIVER SOLID WASTE ASSOCIATION and the counties wish to change the provisions in the INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT which deal with issuance of Revenue Bonds and the solid waste superintendent.

NOW THEREFORE, for in consideration of the mutual benefits to flow to the counties and the citizens residing in each of the counties, and in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and agreements herein contained, the counties hereby agree with each other as follows:

1. Section 1, paragraph (16), on page 5 of the NEW RIVER SOLID WASTE ASSOCIATION INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT is hereby deleted. The following language shall be substituted for that provision and shall constitute the new Section 1, paragraph (16):

(16) "Executive Director" means the Executive Director of the NEW RIVER SOLID WASTE ASSOCIATION, who is the person employed by the Board to direct the Association's operations, supervise the staff and administrative procedures, carry out the functions, duties and responsibilities assigned by the Board, execute
